Suspension of Classes 1B and 1C Due to Respiratory Infection

Dear Parents,

Since several students in classes 1B and 1C have symptoms of upper respiratory tract infections (for example: cough, runny nose, sore throat) and asked for leave, the school has taken the initiative to contact the Centre for Health Protection and Education Bureau. According to instructions from the Centre for Health Protection, classes 1B and 1C will be suspended from November 18 (Wednesday) for at least three days until the Centre for Health Protection inform us that classes can be resumed. This week, the Centre for Health Protection will distribute deep throat saliva test sample bottles to class 1B and 1C students as well as the school staff for testing. During the suspension of classes 1B and 1C, classes will be conducted online in zoom and will be conducted according to the current schedule. If the school receives further guidance from the Education Bureau or Centre for Health Protection, it will notify students and parents as soon as possible.

In order to prevent the spread of respiratory infections in our school, the school will strengthen disinfection work throughout the school. If parents find that their child has symptoms of upper respiratory tract infections, including: fever (mouth temperature higher than 37.5°C, or ear temperature higher than 38°C), cough, runny nose and sore throat, etc., you must ask for leave for your child and allow your child to stay at home while seeking medical advice as soon as possible. Parents are also advised to arrange for their children to be tested for Covid-19 to ensure safety, and inform the school as soon as possible after being informed of the test results. Please take contingency measures.

The school urges parents to follow the health guidelines from the Center for Health Protection and take appropriate preventive measures to prevent upper respiratory tract infections and coronavirus diseases. For details, please visit:

Remarks :

1. The actual resumption date of the 2 classes of 1B and 1C will be based on the review of students medical information by the Center for Health Protection: "Novel Coronavirus Test Results" may be revised. Parents should pay attention to our school's electronic notices and the latest information on the school website.
2. Other classes will go back to school as usual. If parents are worried about upper respiratory tract infections in the school, they can decide on their own whether their children should go back to school. However, our school will not arrange online teaching for the time being. Those missing 7 days will be reported to the Education Bureau. The school will maintain close contact with the Center for Health Protection and closely monitor the health of teachers and students in the school.

3. There will be an arrangement for parents of classes 1B and 1C to collect samples of deep throat saliva test bottles and student exercise books from the school. Details will be announced as soon as possible. Please pay attention.
