To broaden pupils' knowledge and enrich their life-wide learning, Integrated Learning Week will be organized for all students. The arrangements are as follows:

Aims:

1. Through exposure to different activities students will learn different skills to enhance their learning experience.
2. To implement STEM education and make use of experiential learning for students to learn about different areas.
3. Students will develop various abilities through visits, exhibitions and seminars; and through subsequent cooperative learning, project design, and presentations of their work.
4. Students will develop their self-directed learning and bilingual skills.

***Please note that Integrated Learning Week is a valuable opportunity for students to learn beyond books and classrooms so they should not be absent** (with the exception of students with a proper sick leave certificate signed by a doctor).

Notes for students about Integrated Learning Week:

1. Prepare colour pencils, stationery or other materials related to your project.
2. Bring your handbook every day.
3. Bring water and snacks.
4. Toys and games are not allowed.
5. Please wear the proper normal school uniform(except visiting days).
6. Stick to the timeline and work attentively.

Notes for Students Learning Outside the School:

1. Wear a P.E. uniform.
2. Prepare water, cap and mosquito repellent (if needed).

Safety Rules for Learning Outside the School:

Students must not lean their heads or hands out of the windows of the school bus.

- No running or playing.
- Listen to the teachers or the site tour guide.
- Don't wander away, always follow the teachers or the site tour guide.
- Follow the site's rules.
- Respect other visitors.
- Eating or drinking is not allowed on the school bus or in the museum/site.

After arriving at the destination, students must obey the Rules of Museum/Exhibition Centre and are only allowed to have activities at the area specified by teachers.

In case of accident, students should keep calm and report the problem to the nearest teacher for appropriate action.

Students need only bring water, snacks for recess, their handbook, stationery, and color pencils.
