Free Lunch at School

Dear Parents,

School lunch starts on the 8<sup>th</sup> of September 2025 (Monday). Students are required to eat lunch at school. The EDB will continue to provide lunch for free at schools for eligible primary students in the 2025/26 school year. Eligible parents are now invited to join the program. According to the requirements/principles set out by the CCF, Primary 1 to Primary 6 students meeting all the following criteria can participate in the program.

Eligible Students	<p>(1) are receiving a <b><u>full grant in the 2025/26</u></b> school year under the Student Financial Assistance Schemes (SFAS);</p> <p>[Note: Parents are required to submit <b><u>documentary proof</u></b> on SFAS full grant status (i.e. Notification of Result for Assessment of Eligibility 2025/26 or Eligibility Certificate 2025/26) for the school to facilitate the school to arrange lunch payments for eligible students.]</p> <p>(2) <b><u>have lunch arranged by ordering lunch boxes from the lunch supplier “Uncle Bento” through the “Uncle Bento by HKT” mobile APP.</u></b></p> <p>[Note: Students bringing their own packed lunch to school or parents bringing lunches to students will not be provided with the subsidy]</p>
Principles	<p>The lunch subsidy will be disbursed by the Education Bureau (EDB) to participating schools directly. Schools are required to make the lunch charges on behalf of the eligible students.</p>
Points to Note	<p>(1) Parents can decide whether to participate.</p> <p>(2) There is <b><u>no retroactive payment</u></b> for the subsidy. <b>If parents have pre-paid for lunch without determining their grant status or failing to produce related documentary proof (or other conditions such as late submission of documentary proof or students being newly admitted to school), calculation of the subsidy will be from the time when the next pre-payment is made.</b></p> <p>(3) The information provided by parents is used only for the processing of the application for lunch subsidies.</p> <p>(Remark: If required, the school may provide the lunch supplier with the name of your child but only relating to processing matters in relation to the lunch subsidy program.)</p>
