E-learning

As a knowledge-based, technologically driven society, Hong Kong is well placed to widely adopt e-learning. In order to grow with these changes, our school has implemented e-learning to enhance the effectiveness of learning and teaching.

E-learning is a kind of learning utilizing electronic technologies to access educational curriculum outside of the traditional classroom. In many cases, it refers to a course, program or degree delivered completely online. In our school, our teachers have been using e-learning platforms such as online video, Google for Education (Google classroom, Google drive, Google docs, Google slides etc.), education apps and QR codes for enhancing teaching performance. E-learning reduces teaching and learning boundaries and interactive communication between teachers and students can occur anytime, anywhere.

With all its benefits, we would therefore like to invite you to work with us by encouraging your child to take part in e-learning. Your child will have better results if you are alongside them as they engage in e-learning tasks.

Homework policy

Homework is indispensable to learning and teaching. The right amount of homework can enhance learning. We define homework as any school related work activity that students do outside of lesson time independently or with parents. The purpose of homework is to encourage students to develop confidence and self-discipline while working independently.

Homework is not confined to written forms only. A variety of assignments such as reading books, pre-lesson study, internet searches, watching documentaries, etc. are encouraged to cater to learner diversity.

Drill work should be kept to a minimum. The focus of homework should be on the quality not the quantity.

In addition, homework should not prevent students from participating in after school activities such as reading, sports, music or time together with family. Students should allow sufficient time for those activities in addition to homework.

Here are some estimated times for homework per day.

Level	Approximate time
P.1-P.2	45-60 minutes
P.3-P.4	50-70 minutes
P.5-P.6	60-90 minutes
