Content of parent-teacher phone communication in August (Starting on 24/8)


(1) Class teacher's self-introduction

(2) In response to the epidemic, the Education Bureau announced that face-to-face classes are not available for the time being, and students do not need to return to school. Parents should pay attention to the news, school website and school notices.

(3) Ask about the health of students and parents.

(4) Class Teachers continue to follow students' departure from Hong Kong.

(5) Since face-to-face lessons are not available, the school will prepare online learning materials and homework for students. A suggested learning timetable will be provided. Parents please encourage their children to complete the learning tasks. Teachers will record the students' homework completion and attendant of ZOOM tutorial. There will be a reward program and students who perform well will be rewarded.



#The suggested learning timetable will be attached in the student handbook (P.70).

In order to ensure that students know how to use ZOOM, the class teacher will conduct a ZOOM trial with the whole class and teach the etiquette rules of using ZOOM to teach. The time of ZOOM trials for different grades are as follows:

ZOOM's link, password and instructional video will be distributed to students via school GOOGLE email on 1/9/2020.

Mention class teachers will record the students who failed to use ZOOM after the ZOOM trial, and parents will be contacted by phone or in person on 4/9-9/9 and assistance offered.

(6) Ask about which device students use for learning at home (if it is a tablet, mobile phone or laptop, please encourage parents to bring the device back to school on the day of picking up the books), and find out if the student can access the school website and Google.

(7) Notify the parents of the time period for picking up books at school. In order to avoid crowds, parents must arrive at the school according to the time allocated by the teacher, and each student should only be accompanied by 1 or 2 parents. Parents have to bring student's handbook (first/second term of 19-20) as the proof student's identity. Parents and students must wear masks when they come to school. As parents need to deal with a large number of notices and e-learning issues in addition to collecting books that day, please reserve enough time and bring shopping bags to carry materials.
