The Education Bureau has informed us that Primary 6 students can apply for cross-net allocation of the SSPA 2018/2020. If you live outside the Tuen Mun district and would like to choose secondary schools in the district you live for Part B in Central Allocation next April, you may apply. The deadline is 19th December, 2019. If you and your family are going to move to another district, you should pay attention to the following arrangements:

- 1) If you apply, you should provide the school with an application letter containing your signature and evidence of moving or residential district.
- 2) The district you apply for your child must be the only district in which your child lives.
- 3) Proof of residential district must show the name of parents or guardians.
- 4) If necessary, the Education Bureau will contact relevant parents or guardians directly to confirm the correctness of the supporting documents.
- 5) If your child is applying for cross-net allocation, and has submitted applications to secondary schools for discretionary places before moving home and you wish to cancel the discretionary place applications, please inform the secondary schools concerned in writing. You should also inform our school and give us a copy of the letter(s) for our records.
- 6) After the first batch of applications, applications will continue for students until the final deadline for applications in early March 2020.
- 7) Generally, no applications are accepted after the close of the final batch of applications.

If your child needs to apply for cross-net allocation, please inform the class teacher as soon as possible on or before 19th December, 2019.
