Community Care Fund Assistance Programme - Subsidy to Needy Secondary Students for Purchasing Mobile Computer Devices to Facilitate e-Learning

Dear Parents,

Our school is planning to launch the "Bring Your Own Device (BYOD)" programme to cope with the epidemic while supporting e-learning in 2020/21 school year. Since the BYOD programme may add a financial burden on students from low-income families, the Education Bureau has launched Community Care Fund (CCF) for application. Since 2018/19 school year, the fund has subsidized students to purchase mobile computer devices to foster e-learning.

Eligible Beneficiaries

Students are eligible if they fulfill the following requirements:

1. Receiving the Comprehensive Social Security Assistance (CSSA) from the Social Welfare Department; or
2. Receiving the 2020/21 full grant / half grant of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme from the Student Financial Office of the Working Family and Student Financial Assistance Agency.

Subsidized Amount

1. Students receiving the CSSA or full grant of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme are entitled to have a full subsidy to purchase a mobile computer device. The maximum subsidy for each student is \$4,740. In other words, the subsidy provided is the actual cost of the device or \$4,740, whichever is lower.
2. Students receiving a half grant of the School Textbook Assistance Scheme are entitled to have a half subsidy, the subsidy provided is half of the actual cost of the device for up to HK.\$2,370.

Remarks:

1. Each beneficiary student can receive funding only once and purchase one mobile computer device.
2. The Education Bureau will issue subsidies to schools for purchasing devices on behalf of students.
3. When a student beneficiary is promoted to a secondary school or has changed to a new school using a different device and the original device could not meet the learning needs of the new school, the beneficiary can then be provided an additional subsidy for purchasing a new device. In such a case, the student concerned is required to return the used device to the original school that may then use the device for teaching or loan it to other needy students transferred in during the school year.
