COVID-19 Special Arrangements

10th January, 2022

Dear Parents,

In response to the recent spread of the COVID-19 Omicron variant in Hong Kong, the epidemic situation may deteriorate rapidly. The government announced a series of stringent measures on January 5, 2022 to deal with the development of the epidemic. Epidemic prevention measures are implemented at school in accordance with the "Health Protection Measures for Schools" issued by the Education Bureau and the "Health Advice to Schools for the Prevention of Coronavirus Disease" issued by the Department of Health. The school will adopt the following arrangements:

A. Activities affected by the epidemic

Date	Activity	Follow up
12-1-2022 (Wed)	P.6 Visit	Visit will be cancelled. Students will have normal lessons.
17-1-2022 (Mon) to 25-1-2022 (Tue)	P.1- P.6 Integrated Learning Week	Learning activities will continue as usual, but all outings will be cancelled.
22-1-2022 (Sat)	PTA Family Outing	The paid fees will be returned to the parents. Online parent-child seminars and activities will be arranged for participants. Details will be announced by E-class notice soon.
24-1-2022 (Mon)	School holiday	Remains the same.
26-1-2022 (Wed) to 27-1-2022 (Thur)	Distribution of textbooks and exercise books	Remains the same.
28-1-2022 (Fri)	Chinese New Year Learning Day	Remains the same. Only students can participate. Booth games are cancelled.
28-1-2022 (Fri)	Chinese New Year Decoration Class	Selected parents do not need to come to school. Teaching videos will be uploaded to the school website instead. Decoration materials will be distributed to selected parents soon.

B. School Campus Cleansing and Hygiene

- 1. School janitors will clean and disinfect the school campus regularly, this includes toilets, covered playground, staircases, etc.
- 2. Our school has hired an outsourced service for regular atomized school disinfection.
- 3. Students must clear their desks and drawers every day before leaving school to enable thorough cleaning. Students should take stationery, books and all personal belongings home. Do not leave anything in the classroom.
- 4. We will maintain the highest standard of environmental hygiene on our school to safeguard our student's health. We hope students can enjoy learning in a safe environment.
- 5. We have urged all staff members, including janitors, school bus drivers and school bus nannies to step up precautionary measures to maintain personal and environmental hygiene of the school. We will also request all staff who have contact with students, including drivers and school bus nannies, to check their body temperature before going to school. If they have a fever, they will not return to school.
- 6. The school has alcohol hand sanitizer in all classrooms and special rooms. If students are allergic to alcohol hand sanitizer, they should prepare their own hand sanitizer.
- 7. Drinking fountains and the vending machine will be temporarily closed. Students should bring enough water to school.

C. Cooperation with Parents

Cooperation from parents and students is important for us in maintaining a clean and safe environment. We call on your support to step up environmental hygiene in your household, and, on top of that, strictly implement the following measures:

- 1. Pay attention to the health of your child. If he/she is feeling unwell (even if the symptoms are very mild), they should seek medical advice promptly to receive appropriate diagnosis and treatment.
- 2. Check your child's body temperature before he/she goes to school every day. Fill in the record sheet and sign your name on it. Your child should return the completed sheet to us daily.
- 3. To prevent infections, please ask your child to wear a mask (also applicable when taking school buses or other transportation) and bring a spare mask, tissue paper and alcohol hand rub (if needed) to school every day.
- 4. Portable air purifiers or goggles should be simple (if needed). Students should put their name tab on them and keep them properly to themselves.
- 5. To avoid taking your child to crowded places with poor ventilation.
- 6. Help your child to maintain a balanced diet, regular exercise and adequate rest to strengthen their immunity.
- 7. You are requested to <u>notify our school at 2450-2270</u> immediately in case of any of the following situations, to facilitate our prompt action in taking contingency measures and informing the EDB:
 - (a) Your child has a confirmed infection of COVID-19; or
 - (b) Your child has been classified as having "close contact with a COVID-19 infected person".*
- For those who are living or have been present at any specified premises for more than two hours at any time, must undergo compulsory Covid-19 testing. When returning to school, persons subject to compulsory testing (parents and students) must keep the SMS notification containing the result of the test and show the SMS notification or relevant certificate confirming negative test results to the school.

The school will continuously monitor the development of the fluctuating pandemic situation. Parents should pay close attention to the latest announcements of our school as well as the EDB. With the cooperation of everyone we can get through the difficult times the pandemic brings, and that the lives of teachers, students and parents will be back to normal soon!
