Dear Parents,

Omicron cases in Hong Kong have been on the rise recently. The Education Bureau (EDB) announced on 11 January that all primary schools, kindergartens, and kindergarten-cum-child care centres in Hong Kong should suspend face-to-face classes and all on-campus activities (including the cancellation or postponement of examinations and other activities within school premises) on or before 14 January 2022 until the schools' Chinese New Year holidays. At the same time, due to the compulsory testing announcement announced by the Government on the same day, many staff and students are required to undergo compulsory testing on 6 required testing days. It is not advisable to enter the campus while waiting for the report after each test.

You are requested to notify our school at 2450-2270 immediately in case of any of the following situations, to facilitate our prompt action in taking contingency measures and informing the EDB:

- (a) Your child has been confirmed infection of COVID-19; or
- (b) Your child has been classified as "close contact of an infected person" with COVID-19.

If a student is designated as a person who needs to undergo compulsory testing, the student must complete the test and obtain a negative result before returning to school. They also need to show the test result to the school or WhatsApp the result to 9684-8537 or 6760-1569.

The school will continuously monitor the development of the fluctuating pandemic situation. Parents should pay close attention to the latest announcements of our school as well as the EDB. With the cooperation of everyone we can get through the difficult times this pandemic brings, and that the lives of teachers, students and parents will be back to normal soon!
