Dear Parents,

The Government announced on 20 January 2022, setting out the updated arrangements for students aged 5 to 17 to receive Sinovac vaccine and BioNTech vaccine. In gist, children aged 5 to 11 may receive Sinovac vaccine starting from 21 January 2022 or BioNTech vaccine at Children Community Vaccination Centre (CCVC) starting from 16 February 2022. There should be at least 150 participants for school to apply for the Vaccination Subsidy Scheme School Outreach service through the EDB. Besides, there are many applications for this service from schools and the process would take some time. It is suggested that parents to arrange the COVID-19 vaccination for your children by themselves for protection.

The Government implements the "vaccine pass" arrangement starting from February 24, 2022, including all school staff, parents, nannies, volunteers and those who provide services on campus must present the "LeaveHomeSafe" scanning records and records of having received at least the first dose of the COVID-19 vaccine if they want to enter our school, otherwise they will not be able to enter the school premises. The above "vaccination pass" arrangement does not apply to students.
