Dear Parents,

In response to World Book Day and to promote a reading culture, our school will hold a "Reading Festival" on 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2024 (Tuesday). The activities are scheduled as follows:

Events	Details
Competition	P.1-2: Book Cover Competition P.3-5: New Story Ending Competition
Drama and Workshops	P.1-3: English Story Drama "The Rabbit's Most Precious Gift" P.4-6: Information Literacy Workshop "Talking to Students and Teachers about News and Information"
Game Booths	Multiple game booths will be set up at the covered playground for students to play, allowing students to deepen their understanding of different stories and story characters through games.
Book Crossing	Students can bring books they no longer read at home back to school to try to exchange them with other students, or they can store them in classroom reading corner for students to read at their convenience. (See attachment 1 for details)
Book Character Dress Up	Students choose their favourite character from a book, dress up and perform a role-play of that character. (See attachment 2 for details)

Remark:

1. Students only need to bring student handbook, stationery, and colored pens back to school on the day of the activity. There is no need to bring textbooks and homework.
2. If students want to participate in Book Crossing, please bring the books you no longer read at home to the library and give them to librarian Ms Yuen from March 26 to March 27 (See attachment 1 for details).
3. On the day of the activity, students can dress up as characters from a book. If your child does not wish to participate in this activity, they should return to school wearing their school uniform (See attachment 2 for details).
4. That day is a regular school day (8:05 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.), and your child is not allowed to be absent without an excuse. If your child needs to be absent due to illness, please follow the general leave application procedures.
5. After-school interest classes and homework tutorial classes will continue as usual.

## Book Crossing

Our school will hold "Book Crossing" activities to share good books with other book lovers and cultivate a reading culture. In addition, exchanging books not only saves money but also promotes the reuse of resources and contributes to environmental protection.

Students can donate books to the school in exchange for book coupons within a specified time. They can then redeem the book coupons for books donated by other students on 9<sup>th</sup> April. If students cannot choose suitable books on that day, they can exchange book coupons for smart chops, and the unexchanged books will be stored in the classroom reading corner for students to read.

Method:	1 book for 1 book coupon *Book coupons will be distributed to students on 9 <sup>th</sup> April

### 2. Book redemption

Date:	9 <sup>th</sup> April

Method:	1 book coupon for 1 book or 1 book coupon for 2 smart chops

Donation Guidelines:

- Donated books cannot be retrieved.
- We only accept children books suitable for ages 4 to 12, in Chinese or English.
- Books in good to perfect condition only.
- Please remove the name sticker beforehand.
- No textbooks, exercise books, travel books or children magazines will be accepted.

## **Book Character Dress Up Day**

Our school will hold an event titled “Book Character Dress Up Day”. Through this activity, we hope that students will be able to enhance their interest in reading, develop their creativity and further their understanding of the characters in books. We encourage students to choose a favourite character from a book, dress up and perform a role-play of the character on 9<sup>th</sup> April. The details of the event are as follows:

Date:	9 <sup>th</sup> April, 2024 (Tuesday)
Location:	Classrooms
Format:	Participants are required to dress up and act as a character in a storybook, introduce the character or perform one of the plots in the story at a specified time.
Time limit:	3 minutes for each performance
Clothing:	Prepare by students (encourage to use recycled materials)
Awards:	Best Performance Award and Best Costume Award for each class

### Remarks:

1. Students participating in the activity are required to return to school with the relevant books or printed book covers on the day of the activity.
2. Students can choose whether they would like to participate in the activity or not. Students who do not participate in the activity need to wear school uniform to school as usual.
