

Islamic Primary School Notice
Notifying Successful Discretionary Places (DP) Applicants

Dear Primary 6 Parents,

Under the arrangements for notifying successful DP applicants, all participating secondary schools (including Jockey Club Ti-I College) are required to, after processing DP applications, notify parents of all successful applicants of their children's inclusion in the Successful Lists for Discretionary Places by letter and phone **on 27th March, 2024 (Wednesday)**. These notification arrangements are not applicable to reserve and unsuccessful applicants, **nor are the notifications the allocation results**. The parents concerned do not need to reply to the schools if they would accept the DP offers or not.

Parents who have registered as SSPA e-Platform users may also view notifications for successful DP applicants via the SSPA-e-Platform starting from around 10 a.m. on 27th March, 2024. In addition, parents may register with "iAM Smart+" and SSPA e-Platform as early as possible for more convenient and faster services throughout the entire Secondary 1 (S1) application process. Until late July 2024, parents who have not yet activated their SSPA e-Platform accounts may still use the "Activation Code" previously distributed by schools to do so.

If parents who receive notifications from participating secondary schools have also successfully applied for a school place in a non-participating Direct Subsidy Scheme secondary school (NDSS secondary school) for their children, and they decide to retain the DP offered by a public sector secondary school, they should notify the NDSS secondary school concerned and retrieve the signed Parent's Undertaking and the original of the Primary 6 Student Record Form **on or before 10th April, 2024 (Wednesday)** in order to retain the DP which they have successfully obtained. The retrieval of relevant documents will serve as confirmation that the parents concerned have surrendered the S1 school place previously offered by the NDSS secondary school.
